

# FOURTH GRADE EXIT EXPECTATIONS

**Fourth Grade exit expectations for entrance into Fifth Grade**  
**These are the skills we desire parents to reinforce during the summer.**

Students exiting **FOURTH GRADE** are expected in the area of **MATHEMATICS** to:

- Master basic multiplication and division facts up to 12's.
- Multiply 3 digit by 2 digit numbers.
- Divide 2 and 3 digit numbers by a 1 digit divisor with remainders
- State whole number place value up to the millions place
- Round to the nearest 10, 100, and 1000 and nearest dollar amount
- Select and use appropriate standard units to measure (inches, feet and yards)
- Identify and describe different types of figures
  - solids (i.e. cubes, spheres, cones etc.)
  - polygons (i.e. triangles, quadrilaterals, hexagons, etc.)

Students exiting **FOURTH GRADE** are expected in the area of **READING** to:

- Identify author's purpose (to entertain, inform, persuade)
- Apply context clues to figure out the meaning of an unknown word
- Be able to identify the genre of a story
- Write a one paragraph summary of a story using the four main elements of a story (characters, setting, problem, and solution)
- Identify antonyms and synonyms
- Identify the main idea of a passage
- Differentiate between fact and opinion

Students exiting **FOURTH GRADE** are expected in the area of **LANGUAGE ARTS/ WRITING** to:

- Identify parts of an expository essay
- Recognize and use nouns, verbs, and adjectives
- Use proper conventions in writing including indentation, capitalization, and punctuation

Students exiting **FOURTH GRADE** are expected in the area of **STUDY SKILLS** to:

- Utilize an assignment notebook independently
- Utilize a dictionary, glossary, and thesaurus
- Read and understand a basic outline
