

Kindergarten Weekly Week of November 12-16, 2018

Language Arts/Reading: Learning high frequency popcorn word "go" and reading the popcorn word book, We Go. Learning about the "an" word family.

How to help: Your child will be assessed on the first 8 popcorn words. I will share the results with you at our parent teacher conference as well as a "Popcorn Word Fun" packet that help you practice the words with your child at home.

Math: Continuing number sense unit 1-10 (mixed with a little turkey fun)

How to help: Have your child practice writing the numbers with as many different writing utensils as possible. Pencil, marker, crayon, highlighter, colored pencils...whatever you can find. You can also have your child make a number book. Write a number on each page and then draw a set of something to match the number (fall things, sports things, shapes, toys etc).

Social Studies: We will be learning about the first Thanksgiving and the reason why the holiday started (a harvest celebration between the Native Americans and the Pilgrims). We will be making a retelling book about this. We will also be reading many other Thanksgiving books and doing various projects around the holiday. We will be having a feast on Friday (pumpkin bread...made by us, popcorn and apple juice).

Other: Tuesday, November 14th is hearing screening. The rescreen date is November 28th. When it comes to this screening, no news is good news. If your child did not pass the screening you will be notified by our school nurse. No school for students Monday, November 19 - Friday, November 23.
